PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION!!!

1. No inspection will be made until all of the paperwork and proper fee have been submitted. This includes
 - a. Worker's Compensation Affidavit
 - b. Liability insurance certificate or homeowner's waiver
 - c. Utility authorization number from Mass Electric (800) 375-7405 for any work involving electrical service
 - d. Security System Contractor License from the Department of Public Safety for installation of burglar alarms
2. Off-hour inspections. An electrical contractor performing work that requires power restoration from Mass Electric has the option of scheduling an off-hour inspection at a time other than regular office hours, which are 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday, at a cost of \$200.00, in addition to the original permit fee. This off-hour inspection offers the contractor the convenience or option of getting power restored as quickly as possible. Otherwise, the inspection and approval to Mass. Electric will be done during normal working hours.
