Certain items will require a disposal fee.

Items collected at no charge (limit 10 gallons):

Oil-based paint (NO LATEX), paint thinner, varnishes, stains, motor oil, household cleaners, weed killer, insecticides, pesticides, glue, adhesives, rechargeable batteries, aerosol cans, antifreeze, oil filters, art supplies, photo chemicals, etc.



Medications in original packaging from the pharmacy.



Items collected for a fee:

TVs/Monitors up to 60 inches - \$20.00; over 60 inches - \$ 50.00

Tires with or without rims- \$3.00/ea. (car tires); \$ 10.00/ea. (truck tires)

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED: THERMOMETERS, NEEDLES/
SHARPS, OR ANY MEDICAL WASTE INCLUDING RADIOACTIVE AND BIO-HAZARDOUS
MATERIALS.
