**Adoption By The Randolph Town Council To  
Amend the Traffic Rules and Regulations of the Town of Randolph**

Motion is to take appropriate action to amend the traffic rules and regulations of the Town of Randolph and direct the Town Manager, with appropriate funding, to implement the following:

**Mazzeo Drive at the West Street Connector:** Installation of traffic signals with pre-emptor using smart technology.

**West Street at the West Street Connector:** Install stop signs creating a three way stop.

**West Street at LaFayette Street:** Using the plan approved by council narrow the intersection by pulling the curb line out, install granite curbing, realigning the Semensi Island.

**LaFayette Street at Grove Street:** Using the plan provided decrease the width of the opening of Grove Street at LaFayette.

**LaFayette Street in the area of Tower Hill School:** Install electronic speed check signage as appropriate.

**LaFayette Street where it intersects with High Street:** Using the plan provided, reconstruct the layout of High Street.

**High Street at Chestnut Street and Chestnut West:** Using the plan provided reconstruct the intersection to provide left turn lane onto Chestnut from High, more of a controlled right turn from High Street onto Chestnut, realigning of curbing to comply with plan and installation of raised islands.

**High Street at various locations:** According to site conditions, construct one or more center line islands with planting and shade trees.

**High Street at Canton Street:** Install a full traffic signal with Smart technology with pre-emptor and full pedestrian signals. Installation of raised islands.

**High Street at Reed Street:** Install Smart technology to existing traffic signal.

**High Street at Edwin Street:** Installation of traffic island and cross walk in area of baseball fields.

**In all areas:** Install appropriate signage as needed, all islands should accommodate planting areas, those center line islands shall have appropriate high canopy shade trees, all areas of existing asphalt that are reclaimed from traveled ways shall be loomed and seeded. Those areas directly abutting residential dwellings will be sent a letter with a request of the abutter to help us by maintaining this new green area by mowing, etc.

**Tower Hill Historic signage:** Shall be appropriately relocated to a prominent spot at the newly reconstructed intersection.

8/7/17 – Introduced by Councilor Burgess. Councilor Burgess made a motion to take appropriate action to amend the traffic rules and regulations of the Town of Randolph and direct the Town Manager with appropriate funding, to implement. Seconded by Councilor Gilbert. Councilor Goldstein invoked Section 21\*.

8/21/17 – Councilor Burgess read each line item as a motion, seconded by Councilor Gilbert. Councilor Goldstein made a motion to table until the next meeting. Motion failed for lack of a second.

Councilor Burgess made an amendment to the motion to include installation of round islands/rotaries at Niles and Althea and Niles and Smith, seconded by Councilor Gilbert. Vote: 7-1-0 (Councilor Goldstein in the negative).

Councilor Adams made a motion to continue and have a public hearing at the next meeting, seconded by Councilor Goldstein.




**Adoption by The Randolph Town Council of Amendments to the


05/07/2018 – Introduced by Town Manager David Murphy.

**Adoption By The Randolph Town Council  
Of Amendments the Traffic Rules and Regulations  
Of the Town of Randolph**

**Ordered:** The Town Council hereby amends the Traffic Rules and Regulations of the Town of Randolph as follows:


1. Denise Drive shall be a one-way street from High Street to Reed Street.
2. The Town shall install stop signs at the following locations:
  - a. Highland Avenue where it intersects with Stoughton Street;
  - b. Stoughton Street east and west where it intersects with Highland Avenue;
  - c. Grove Street at Lafayette Street;
  - d. High Street at Lafayette Street;
  - e. Smith at Niles; and
  - f. Althea at Niles.
3. The Town shall install stop signs at the following locations on an interim basis until traffic lights are installed at these locations:
  - a. the intersection of Lafayette and West Street is a 3 way stop sign;
  - b. the intersection of West Street and West Street Connector; and
  - c. the intersection of West Street Connector and Mazzeo/Warren.
4. There shall be right turn and left turn striping at High Street.
5. A cross walk is authorized on High Street at North Randolph Little League Field.
6. Traffic lights are authorized at the intersection of Canton Street and High Street.
7. Traffic lights are authorized at the intersection of Lafayette and West Street.
8. Traffic lights are authorized at the intersection of West Street and West Street Connector.
9. Traffic lights are authorized at the intersection of West Street Connector and Mazzeo/Warren.
10. The speed limit is increased from 25 mph to 30 mph on High Street between Canton Street and Scanlon Drive.

06/11/2018 – Introduced by Town Manager David Murphy. Councilor Clifton made a motion to table Council Order 2018-028, seconded by Councilor Clerger. Vote: 7-1-0 (Councilor Burgess in the negative, Councilor Egan not present for the vote).

6/25/18 – Public Hearing held. Councilor Adams made a motion to remove Council Order 2018-028 from the table, seconded by Councilor Clerger. Vote: 7-0-0. Councilor Burgess made a motion to approve Council Order 2018-028 with the following amendment” under 3a, add “(3 way stop sign)” after Lafayette and West Street. Seconded by Councilor C. Alexopoulos. Vote: 7-0-0
