ALL TRASH AND RECYCLE MUST BE OUT AT CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM

Residential Curbside Trash and Recycling Collection Services in Randolph are provided by: **Capitol Waste Services, Inc.**
This guide has been created to provide you with updated information through June 2026.

TRASH COLLECTION RULES

All carts and scheduled bulk items must be at the curb by **7:00 AM** on your trash day.

Pick up times may vary.

All trash must be **INSIDE** the provided trash cart. Loose bags of trash and garbage will not be picked up.



Lids on all bins must be closed.

RECYCLING COLLECTION RULES

Cart must be at the curb with the wheels facing your home by **7:00 AM** of your scheduled pick-up day.

Items left outside of the cart will not be collected.



All carts must have **3 feet** of space around them for the truck to pick up the cart.

H HOLIDAY COLLECTION

When an observed holiday falls on a normal collection day, the collections will be delayed by one (1) day for the rest of the week. (ie. If Monday is a holiday, and pick up is usually on Friday, your trash pick up will be delayed one day to Saturday.)

B BULK / OVERSIZED ITEM PICK UP (Must Schedule 1 Week in Advance)

Bulk items **must** be scheduled one week in advance of your regular trash day. Do not place items at the curb until the evening before. To schedule bulk/oversized item (free of charge) pick-up, call the Health Dept. at (781)-961-0924 or go to the town website, www.randolph-ma.gov, and look under "Residents" > "Trash" > "Bulk / Oversized Items".

Accepted: toilets with tank removed, sofas, recliners, desks, chairs, large toys, lawn furniture, & rugs bundled in 3 ft. pieces. Limit of 3 items per week. **Not Accepted:** appliances (stoves, refrigerators, washer/dryer, freezers, water heaters or air conditioners), mattresses, boxsprings, wood, construction debris, doors and windows. See the back page to learn how to dispose of a mattress or box spring. For all other items, please visit RecyclingWorksMA.com to search for a private hauler that can manage unaccepted materials.

C CURBSIDE YARD WASTE - TOWN WIDE

Place Yard Waste out by **7:00 AM**.

Curbside Yard Waste is picked up 6 times a year on dates: **November 8, November 22, and December 6 (2025); May 2, May 16, and June 13 (2026).**

Yard waste is leaves, grass clippings, small branches / brush less than 1 inch diameter and 3 feet long. Yard waste and small branches can be placed in paper bags, (not plastic) or loose in barrels or cardboard boxes.

+ MEDICAL WASTE DROP OFF



Used syringes and sharps in secure puncture proof containers may be brought to the Randolph Public Health Department located at the Town Hall, 41 South Main Street, first floor.

B BATTERY & BULB SHED

Drop off items such as thermometers, batteries and light bulbs. All other waste prohibited. The shed is located behind 1 Turner Lane.

P HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY

Held on **Saturday, August 9, 2025**, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, rain or shine. Located in the Randolph High School parking lot.

C TOWN WIDE CLEAN UP DAY

Scheduled for **Saturday, April 25, 2026**, from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Volunteers are always needed!

Community Service hours are available for students of all ages. Pre-registration is required.

Call the Public Health Department at (781)-961-0924 to join, volunteer, or ask questions about the program.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I do if my trash/recycling/bulky item(s) wasn't picked up?

If your trash or recycling wasn't picked up, call (781)-961-0924 within 24 hours of the missed collection. You may also use SeeClickFix on www.randolph-ma.gov to report items that were not picked up; must be within 24 hours.

What if I need extra space for my trash?

For additional space for trash, rent an additional trash cart. Cost is \$130.00 per bin, per year. Go to "Residents" > "Trash & Recycling" > "Additional Trash Carts" to pay online. You may also pay via cash or check at the Randolph Health Department at 41 South Main Street, Main Floor.

What is the recycling schedule?

The recycling schedule is bi-weekly, or every other week. Each street has been assigned a color: purple or green. Recycling should be put out on the weeks that correspond with your street's assigned color, on your street's collection day.

What do I put in the blue recycle cart?

On the town website, click "Residents" > "Trash & Recycle" > "How do I dispose of...?" This will direct you to the Recyclopedia tool.

How can I compost organic food scraps?

Open to all Randolph residents.
No commercial waste and no hazardous waste is accepted.

The Drop off Center is open **8:00 AM** until **2:00 PM** on:
Jul 5, Jul 19, Aug 2, Aug 16, Aug 30, Sept 13,
Sept 27, Oct 11, Oct 26, Nov 8, Nov 15 (2025);
Apr 11, Apr 25, May 9, May 23, Jun 6, Jun 20 (2026)

The drop off center is located at **6 Carlino Way**
(behind the Zapustas Ice Arena).

To drop off Yard Waste, residents **must** purchase a **Yard Waste Season Pass**. All other items are collected based on a fee schedule (see items #3-8). State law prohibits disposal of CRTs, (TV monitors and CPU's) in regular trash because of their high lead content. Call the Public Health Department for more information at (781) 961-0924.

MATTRESSES, BOX SPRINGS AND TEXTILES MUST BE RECYCLED Common household items such as mattresses, box springs and textiles, (clothing & shoes) are banned from the municipal solid waste stream and instead must be recycled. 310 CMR 19.000

MATTRESS & BOX SPRING CURBSIDE PICK-UP:

Mattress & Box Spring pick-ups
must be scheduled one week in advance.

+IMPORTANT: \$50.00/piece. Residents can purchase a mattress disposal permit on the Town Website, under "Residents" > "Trash & Recycle" > "Mattress/Box Spring Disposal". Municipality is "Randolph". You may also pay cash or check at the Public Health Office at Town Hall.

TEXTILE MATERIALS DROP-OFF:

Residents can place unwanted clothing and shoes in drop boxes located at **6 Carlino Way** and behind the Food Pantry at **1 Turner Lane**. All clothing and shoes must be contained in plastic bags prior to drop off.

Each drop off is considered a donation to the Big Brother Big Sister Foundation. A QR Code is on each box. Using your smart phone, the QR code will provide a link to download a receipt for tax purposes. The drop boxes are accessible 24 hours per day, however, if they are full; do not leave the clothing, shoes or anything else outside of the drop off boxes.

TEXTILE CURBSIDE PICK-UP SERVICES:

Curbside pickup of textiles and small household items must be scheduled.

Here are 3 Options to Pre-Register for a Pick-Up:

- 1 – www.bbbsfoundation.org/schedule-a-pickup/
- 2 – Voice Mail Box: Call or Text 508-466-4590 and leave your name, phone, and address. Those who correctly register will receive a reminder phone call the day prior to pick up service. On the day of the service, you will also receive a notification.
- 3 – Scan the QR code and schedule your pick up.

Accepted types of Textiles / Household Items:

BAGGED: All types, sizes, and styles of Clothing (women, men, children) ▪ Household Textiles (blankets, towels, curtains) ▪ All Shoes and Sneakers ▪ Accessories (purses, backpacks, belts, jewelry, hats, gloves, socks and more)

BOXED: Kitchen Accessories (pots, pans, dishes, microwave, glasses) ▪ Small Decor Items (vases, picture frames, paintings) ▪ Small Musical Instruments
▪ Books and DVDs ▪ Bicycles
