

# History

- From the 1800 – 1923 Randolph was served by a constabulary, in 1924 by an act of Massachusetts Legislature, the Randolph Police department was created.
- Today, the Randolph Police Department is fully accredited by the Massachusetts Police Accreditation Committee, with 58 members and 10 Operational Units



- In 2017, the department answered 22,910 calls for service.




# Why is Accreditation important ?

- Better service to the community





# Prosecution

- Total Number of Cases brought before the court (2017): 745
- Total Number of Pending Cases (Open District & Superior Cases): 500
- Approximate Number of Pending District Court Cases: 400
- Approximate Number of Pending Superior Court Cases: 100
- Approximate Number of Outstanding Warrants: 451



# Drug Statistics & Enforcement

- Member of the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) since 2011
- Current open Narcotic cases, including neighborhood complaints, tips, officer observations and confidential informants: 158
- Five detectives permanently assigned to the “Street Crimes Unit” with an emphasis on reducing violence and getting dangerous drugs off the street



## Operation “French Connection” March 2017

8 houses searched in Randolph, 18 arrests, 5 kilos of Fentanyl, Heroin and Cocaine seized.

## Operation “High Hopes” February 2018

2.5 Kilos of Fentanyl Seized and multiple arrests, tied to “Silnalowa” tied to the Mexican Drug Cartel

# Randolph Gang Statistics

**Four active Randolph based gangs**, often having ties to well known gangs in the city of Boston and the City of Brockton

**Currently there are 71 identified Boston Gang members living in Randolph belonging to approximately 40 Boston Based Gangs**
