A late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any dog not licensed by April 1, 2016 (in addition to the License Fee). License year is January 1, 2016 - December 21, 2016.

INSTRUCTIONS: RETURN WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS

COMPLIANCE with this State requirement provides proof of residence, protection of voting rights, veteran's bonus, housing for the elderly and related benefits as well as providing information for your community. This form DOES NOT register you as a voter or allow you to change your political party. To register or change party, contact the Town Clerk at (791) 961-0900. You must be a registered voter at least twenty (20) days prior to State Primaries and Elections.

There are four political parties in Massachusetts. If you are enrolled in one of these parties, you will find the following letter codes next to your name in the column marked "Pol. Party" column:

D: Democrat **R:** Republican **CC:** United Independent Party **J:** Green Rainbow

When voting in the **March 1, 2016 Presidential Primary**, voters will be given a ballot for the party in which they are enrolled.

Voters who are unenrolled (commonly known as "Independent") will be listed with a "U" in the Pol. Party column.

Unenrolled voters ("U") and voters with letters other than those listed above can choose which ballot they would like to vote.
