

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I do if my trash/recycling/bulky item(s) wasn't picked up?

If your trash, recycling or bulky item wasn't picked up call 781-961-0925, or email recycling@randolph-ma.gov or use See Click Fix on the town website, <https://www.randolph-ma.gov> (scroll down under "Follow Us").

How can I reduce my trash volume and weight at curbside pick up?

- Recycling clean cardboard can reduce the weight of your trash
- Composting organic food scraps can be done at home.
- Purchase products with less packaging.
- Donate furniture, books, household items, and clothing.
- Your trash is another person's treasure, so use websites such as FreeCycle or Craigslist to get rid of unwanted household items.
- Keep rain and snow out of your trash.

What is the Recycling Schedule?

The recycling schedule is bi-weekly or every other week. Each week is assigned a color; purple or green. Your street will be given a color (purple or green) and you will put out your recycling on your trash day if that week corresponds with your color on the calendar.

What do I do if I miss my recycling day?

Look at the Calendar and put out your Blue Cart the next time it is scheduled to be collected by 7:00am that day.

How do I put out my Blue Recycle Cart?

By 7:00am of your scheduled pick up day, your cart must be out on the sidewalk or driveway with the wheels facing your home or apartment building. All carts must have a three, (3) feet of space around them for the Capitol Waste Services, Inc. truck to pick up the cart. The cart is picked up with mechanical arm that is operated by a driver inside of the truck. It is important that the top of the lid is closed on the Recycle Cart to prevent litter.

What do I put in the Blue Recycle Cart?

- Clean glass bottles and jars
- Clean aluminum cans, tin cans and steel cans.
- Clean plastic bottles, jars, egg cartons and tubs with Triangle Numbers 1, 2 and 5 plastics.
- Clean paper, paper bags, newspaper, corrugated cardboard, box cardboard, paper egg cartons.

What can I do with my old refrigerator, stove, washing machine, dryer or dishwasher?

Appliances (white goods- stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers) can be picked up by scrap metal dealers. The Town of Randolph does not recommend any particular vendor.

What can I do with my scrap metal, construction debris or basement clean outs and other junk?

Scrap metal, construction debris or basement clean outs can be scheduled with junk removal businesses located in the area. The Town of Randolph does not recommend any particular vendor.

What can I do with my old microwave oven, coffee machine, toaster oven?

You can fit it into your approved trash container or bring it to the Residential Drop off Center for Banned Solid Waste at 6 Carlino Way and pay a fee of \$5.00 per item to cover shipping cost.

What can I do with my old smoke detector?

Contact the store in which it was purchased or mail it back to the manufacturer for proper disposal.

Put the following in your Trash Container.

- Empty aerosol containers, food canisters, (for example-Pringles canisters, nut cans, raisin canisters)
- Foil tops, (yogurt containers), plastic lids of all types, tin foil, aluminum foil, coat hangers.
- Plastic bags, plastic film, plastic wrap, plastic plates, plastic cups, plastic bowls, plastic utensils, styrofoam cups, styrofoam packing peanuts, single use coffee pods, tupperware, Flower pots, crates, buckets, empty prescription medicine vials and empty nip bottles.
- Cardboard milk cartons, cardboard juice cartons, paper cups, paper plates, paper bowls, disposable coffee cups, shredded paper, ice cream containers, tissue, napkins, tissue paper, tyvek, plastic padded envelopes, frozen food boxes, garden hoses, rope and string.
- Drinking glasses, ceramic mugs, ceramic plates, dishes, window glass, anything with food waste, fats or food fatty liquids
- All food waste

DO YOUR PART RECYCLE SMART

CARDBOARD/PAPER

- Corrugated Cardboard (Wavy center layer)
- Boxboard (Dry-food boxes, egg cartons, & rolls)
- Junk Mail, Periodicals, & Office Paper (Paper bags, envelopes, & catalogs)

PLASTIC **METAL** **GLASS**

- Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs, & Lids (Empty kitchen, laundry, & bath containers)
- Aluminum & Steel Cans (Foil & empty food & beverage cans)
- Glass Bottles & Jars (Empty food & beverage bottles & jars)

- ✓ No items smaller than 2" in size
- ✓ All containers are empty, rinsed, & dry
- ✓ Cardboard is flattened & broken down
- ✓ There are NO items from the NOT ACCEPTED list in the recycling bin



RANDOLPH TRASH & RECYCLE GUIDE

ALL TRASH AND RECYCLE MUST BE OUT AT CURBSIDE BY 7:00AM

Residents who participate in the curbside pick-up program are able to have Trash and Recyclable material picked up at curbside by following the Town of Randolph Trash and Recycling Policy. Capitol Waste Services, Inc. has been hired by the Town of Randolph to provide curbside service for trash, recycled materials, bulk items and yard waste. You are advised to keep this Policy document and Calendar so that you may refer to it throughout the year.

TRASH COLLECTION RULES

All trash must be placed out at curbside by **7:00 AM**. Pick up times may vary. All trash must be in barrels or closed trash bags which do not exceed 50 pounds.

CURBSIDE TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION ON HOLIDAY WEEKS H

- When Monday is a holiday, Monday collections will be done on Tuesday, and all collections for the rest of the week will be delayed by one, (1) day.
- When holidays fall Tuesday through Friday, residents whose regular trash day falls on or after that holiday will experience a one, (1) day delay in their trash and recycling collection.

BULK ITEM PICK UP

Bulk objects are: toilets with tank removed, mattresses, box springs, sofas, recliners, desks, chairs, large toys, lawn furniture, and rugs bundled in 3ft pieces. Three pieces may be picked up per week. Call the Health Department to schedule a pick up for your regular trash day. Bulk items are NOT: white goods, wood, construction debris, doors and windows. CURBSIDE YARD WASTE ♻️

Curbside Yard Waste 6 times a year on the following dates: Nov 9th, Nov 23rd, and Dec 7th (2019); April 18th, May 9th, and May 23rd (2020). Yard waste is leaves, grass clippings, small branches / brush less than 1 inch diameter and 3 feet long. Yard waste and small branches can be placed in paper bags, (not plastic) or loose in barrels or cardboard boxes.

BATTERY & BULB SHED

Drop off items such as thermometers, batteries and light bulbs. DO NOT drop off any other type of waste. The shed is located behind 1 Turner Lane.

MEDICAL WASTE DROP OFF

Used Syringes and sharps in secure puncture proof containers may be brought to the Randolph Public Health Department located at the Town Hall, 41 South Main Street, 1st floor. Prescription medicines may be dropped off in the self-service kiosk located in the Randolph Police Department lobby.

DPW YARD DROP OFF CENTER FOR BANNED SOLID WASTE ♻️

The drop off center is open to all Randolph residents. No commercial waste and no hazardous waste is accepted. The drop off center is located at 6 Carlino Way behind the Zapustas Ice Arena. To drop off yard waste, residents must purchase a Season Pass. All other waste, such as CRT's are collected based on a fee schedule. State law prohibits disposal of CRTs, (TV's monitors and CPU's) in regular trash because of their high lead content. Call the Public Health Department for more information at 781-961-0925. The Drop off Center is open 8:00 AM until 2:00 PM on July 13th, July 27th, August 10th, August 24th, September 7th, September 21st, October 5th, October 19th, November 2nd, November 16th, April 4th, April 18th, May 2nd, May 16th, May 30th, June 13th, and June 27th. Below, you will find the fees that are collected to use the Residential Drop off Center.
